PA SYSTEM AND LIGHTS

Venue will be responsible for furnishing Professional Grade PA System and Stage Lighting as well as a qualified engineer to operate both systems. Any special requests for lighting and or PA will be communicated with such a person in a reasonable amount of time prior to show time. Special considerations may be made in the event that the venue is not able to furnish the PA system or accommodate the Input needs of the band above, however reasonable notice needs to be given to The Band prior to the date of show.

RIDER

ACCESS:

All Band Members and Crew listed above must have full access to enter/exit Venue, provided Dressing Rooms, Stage and/or any other areas needed to perform on day of show at no cost unless otherwise agreed. Venue will be responsible for issuing credentials to persons listed above on day of show. All Band Members and Crew are 21 years or older and will provide Identification upon request. Any guest lists or additional persons must be discussed by both parties prior to date of show. If Venue cannot accommodate this request notice must be given to Band prior to date of show.

PARKING:

Venue must provide at least 1 parking space for 1 RV (or van in the case of local shows) with trailer with a reasonable amount of space to load/unload gear free of charge. In the event Venue cannot accommodate this request, notice must be given to Band prior to date of show.

SECURITY:

Venue will hold all responsibility for providing security to fit the needs of the show or the Venue day of show. Band and Crew holds no liability for any incidents that may occur on Venue premises day of show. Any security concerns The Venue may have should be discussed with Band and Crew prior to day of show.

MERCHANDISING:

Venue will be responsible for providing an area large enough inside to accommodate a 6 foot table for merchandise accessible to audience during the show. Band and Crew will be responsible for setting up/tearing down and selling/maintaining merchandise while on Venue Premises. All merchandise is the sole property of The Band and should be treated as such. In the event that The Venue cannot accommodate this request, notice must be given to Band prior to date of show.

HOSPITALITY:

Venue will supply water free of charge to band and crew before, during and after performance unless otherwise agreed upon by both parties. Venue will also supply a restroom that band and crew may access at all times. Dressing rooms will be provided on an if possible basis by The Venue.

VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY:

The Band reserves the right to videotape/audio record and or photograph their performance only. If any additional persons are required for this purpose The Band will give notice to Venue prior to date of show. All other Video/Audio Recording and Photography will be at the sole discretion of The Venue.

LOAD IN/OUT:

Venue must provide Band a reasonable amount of time to load in/out all gear and a secure dry space to store such gear before performance if applicable. Venue will make reasonable accommodation to ensure safety of all gear and property belonging to band while on Venue premises. Backline (If applicable) must be discussed prior to show time. Estimated time for load in/out will be provided below.

SOUNDCHECK:

Band must be given a reasonable amount of time to soundcheck prior to their performance. Band agrees to discuss any audio/lighting concerns with engineer prior to show time. All monitor requests will also be discussed with engineer either during soundcheck or prior to show time. Estimated time required for sound check will be provided below.

STAGE SETUP:

The Band may in certain circumstances use Skrims, Risers, Lights and other Equipment such as but not limited to Smoke Machines and Stands not mentioned above during their performance. These items will be provided and set up by the band prior to performance and will be discussed with The Venue prior to show time. The band agrees to modify load in/out and stage setup times to reasonably accommodate venue requirements as well as other bands if needed.

ESTIMATED TIMES: Unloading: 25 mins Stage set up: 15 Mins Soundcheck: 10 Mins Performance: TBD Loading: 25 Mins *These are estimated times and in no way reflect the actual time required for any of these activities.*
